How to Assemble a Playlist for a HYPERWALL PRESENTATION

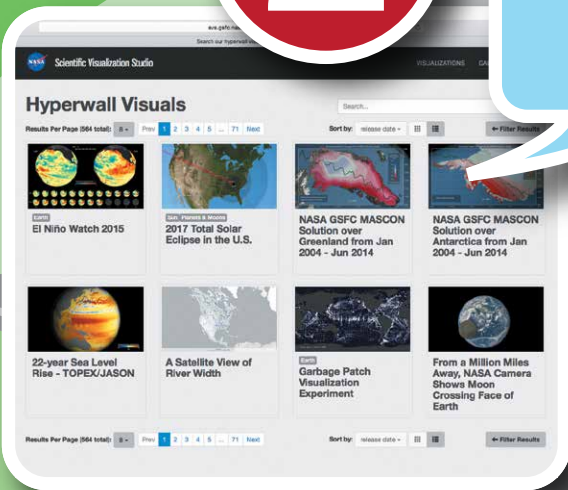
These **6** steps will help you assemble a Hyperwall playlist, i.e., a list of media files, in chronological order, that you'd like to display on the Hyperwall.

1

Choose a topic that you wish to present about. Remember, science that excites and interests you, usually excites and interests your audience, resulting in an exciting and interesting presentation!

2

Search svs.gsfc.nasa.gov/hw to see if there are existing *media files* (animations, movies, still images) that you'd like to show. Click **Filter Results** in the top right to help facilitate your search.
As a general rule of thumb, no more than 6 media items per 10-minute increments.

In addition to existing media, decide if you want to submit new media files.

**If you do not wish to submit new media files and you're happy assembling a playlist using existing media,*

Submit a final playlist of media files (including supporting links) to Steve Graham at steven.m.graham-1@nasa.gov in the order you wish to have them displayed on the Hyperwall during your presentation--see Example Playlist below.

NOTE: Please indicate if media is existing (from svs.gsfc.nasa.gov/hw) or new.

Make sure the media files you're submitting meet Hyperwall requirements--see **Table** below.

NOTE: Native PowerPoint and Keynote files are not supported on the Hyperwall. Media files must be submitted in their original form.

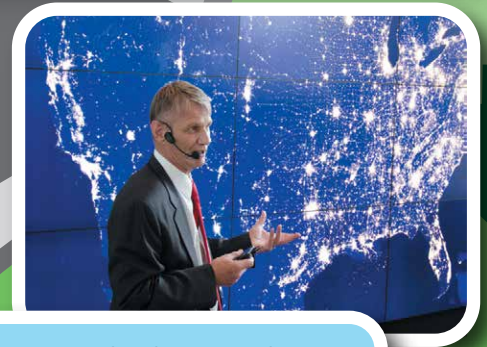
Table: These requirements assume a 3 x 3 arrangement of screens. The resolution of a single screen is 1920 x 1080.
